Together referred to as “the Company”, “We”, “Us” or “Our”.

1. Our Commitment to Privacy

We respect your right to privacy and are committed to protecting the personal information you share with us. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and safeguard your information in accordance with:

- The **UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR)** and the **Data Protection Act 2018**, and
- The **Protection of Personal Information Act 4 of 2013 (POPIA)** of South Africa.

Depending on the nature of your interaction with us, Recruitment and Employer of Record Alliance (RAEORA) Limited and Recruitment and Employer of Record Alliance (RAEORA) (Pty) Ltd may act either independently or jointly in relation to the collection and processing of personal information described in this Privacy Policy. 2. Information We Collect

We may collect and process the following types of personal information:

2.1 Information You Provide Directly

This includes information submitted when you:

- Register on the Website;
- Submit a CV or job application;
- Request information or services;
- Contact us through forms, chat, or email;
- Subscribe to newsletters or job alerts.

The personal data collected may include:

- Name, surname, and contact details (email, phone number, address);
- Employment history, qualifications, and professional information;
- Client company contact and business details;
- User login credentials (if applicable).

2.2 Information Collected Automatically

We may collect data automatically through cookies and analytics tools when you visit our Website, including:

- IP address and browser type;
- Pages visited, time spent, and referring websites;
- Device information and geolocation data.

You can manage your cookie preferences through your browser settings.

3. How We Use Your Information

We use personal information to:

- Facilitate recruitment and HR consultancy services;
- Match candidates to job opportunities;
- Manage client relationships and business development;
- Respond to enquiries and provide requested information;
- Improve our Website and user experience;
- Comply with legal obligations and industry regulations.

We do **not** sell or rent your personal information to third parties.

4. Legal Basis for Processing (UK and EU Users)

Under the UK GDPR, we process personal data on the following legal bases:

- **Consent** – when you voluntarily submit your information;
- **Contract** – when processing is necessary to deliver requested services;
- **Legitimate Interest** – to operate and improve our business;
- **Legal Obligation** – when required by law.

5. Data Transfers

Because our Website operates jointly between the UK and South Africa, your personal data may be transferred between these countries. We ensure all transfers comply with applicable data protection laws and are protected through contractual and technical safeguards.

6. Data Security

We implement appropriate technical and organisational measures to safeguard your data from unauthorised access,

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loss, misuse, alteration, or disclosure. Access to personal data is limited to authorised personnel only.

If we process online submissions, these are encrypted using **SSL (Secure Socket Layer)** technology or equivalent secure protocols. We implement technical, organisational and security measures designed to protect personal information against unauthorised access, disclosure, alteration and destruction.

7. Data Retention

We retain personal information only for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes for which it was collected, or as required by applicable law. Candidate information and CVs may be retained for up to 24 months following the last meaningful interaction, unless a longer retention period is required by law or the individual consents to continued retention for future opportunities.

8. Your Rights

Depending on your location, you may have the right to:

- Access the personal information we hold about you;
- Request correction or deletion of inaccurate or outdated data;
- Withdraw consent for processing (where applicable);
- Object to certain processing activities;
- Request data portability.

UK users also have the right to lodge a complaint with the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) if they believe their personal information has been processed unlawfully or their data protection rights have been infringed.

South African users have the right to lodge a complaint with the Information Regulator of South Africa regarding the processing of their personal information.

We may share information with:

- Legal or regulatory authorities, if required by law.
